Quality of Teaching, Learning & Assessment	To develop teaching for mastery in maths across the school, in particular, to embed a firm understanding of Fluency in all classes through well-equipped and knowledgeable maths teaching, looking at learning and teaching styles, which in turn increases the number of children making expected progress and better than expected progress in maths.
Outcomes for Pupils. Behaviour and Attitudes	To develop a robust system to track and analyse SEND children throughout school and ensure that all groups – gender, SEND, disadvantaged - are given every opportunity for maximum participation and progress.
