Key Priorities for 2024-2025

Quality of Education (Intent, Implementation, Impact)

- 1. To ensure the Catholic Life and Mission of our school is at the forefront of all we do. Continue to ensure a consistent approach to the implementation of the RED curriculum across school.
- 2. Continue to develop the use of high-quality assessment to allow for the most effective learning through challenge and support. Provided through quality first teaching.
- 3. To develop and implement a new Music Strategy Plan that allows all children the opportunities to play an instrument; create music and to progress in their musical knowledge and understanding whilst also developing interest and talents.

Behaviour and Attitudes

4. To continue to revise current policies and procedures relating to behaviour and attitudes, in line with our Catholic ethos. Ensure that opportunities are given for pupils in all groups to support, debate and contribute to the aims, objectives and visions of our school.

Personal Development

5. Continue to provide further opportunities to develop our pupils' character with emphasis on confidence and resilience.

Continue to develop children's leadership roles through School Council, Mini Vinnies and Ethos Group.

Children to maintain their enthusiasm despite any difficulties or setbacks, during a variety of learning situations.
