1	Pushing in queues Running inside Spoiling others' games Teasing	A "look", "social cue", "whistle if needed" Verbal reminder of acceptable behaviour. A positive choice given to improve behaviour.	Welfare staff
2	Name calling Play fighting Rough or aggressive play	Verbal warning/discussion. Positive reinforcement strategies. Choice to improve or accept further sanctions if behaviour continues.	Welfare staff
3	<b><u>Continued:</u></b> Name calling Play fighting Rough or aggressive play <b><u>And/or</u></b> Arguing Refusal to following instructions Leaving class without permission	Yellow Warning Card. Children are spoken to privately away from other children Time out to calm down/ reflect (minutes) Choice to improve or accept further sanctions if behaviour continues	Welfare staff
4	Fighting Graffiti Damaging school property Racist or derogatory remark	Red Card Reflection Form Time out with SLT Communicated with class teacher	Teacher SLT



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	Swearing Inappropriate behaviour online	Recorded on CPOMS Conversations with parents (phone call/ meeting by SLT)	
5	Sexting Stealing Verbal abuse of staff Serious aggressive behaviour against pupils	Internal exclusion / isolation. Loss of privileges – playtime, representing school, after school clubs, responsibilities. Parents called to meeting. External agencies (coercion or blackmail, a child is under 13 or there is immediate risk of harm) IBP – Behaviour plan in place – monitored by SLT. Record of all meetings kept on CPOMS.	SLT
6	Being very disrespectful to adults Serious aggressive behaviour against pupils/staff Serious fighting causing injury to another child Bullying Leaving class without permission Dangerous behaviour, serious challenge to authority or threatening behaviour Racist or derogatory remark	Isolation with SLT for part / all of the day. Parents called to meeting. Pastoral Support Programme. Behaviour plan in place and monitored daily by Headteacher and with parents. External agencies (police for sexting incident where there is adult involvement, coercion or blackmail, a child is under 13 or there is immediate risk of harm) Record of all meetings kept on CPOMS Recorded for report to Governors. Recorded on CPOMS. Behaviour Specialist teacher support	SLT Headteacher
