School Uniform 2022/2023

Only school-approved bags can be brought into the cloakrooms. We have updated our bags and there are now two designs available; a top opening traditional book bag and a satchel-style bag.

In the interests of safety, security and uniformity, the only jewellery children can wear is an inexpensive watch. Children must not wear any watch that can take / receive photos or messages. However, a watch that counts steps e.g. a Fitbit can be worn.

Make-up and nail polish are not permitted. Long hair should be tied up at all times and any hairbands must be in school colours and of a very simple design. Tramlines and other artistic shavings are not permitted in children's hair.

Grey socks
Navy v-neck jumper with the school logo
Black shoes (no boots or trainers)

In the warmer months, particularly after Easter, all girls may wear blue gingham dresses
and boys grey shorts

P.E. Kit

All children need an indoor and outdoor kit throughout the year. On P.E. days, pupils can come to school wearing their school kit. **Please note, other sports or activity wear is not part of our school uniform.**

Forest School Kit

Throughout the school year, pupils have the opportunity to use our Forest School area. You will be notified in advance of which day / dates your child will be using this outside space.
